### **Why do we use a Book of Common Prayer?**

Because worship should first of all be God centered rather than man centered. A liturgy is a useful tool in directing us in worship to be focused upon God rather than upon ourselves. The prayers contained in the Prayer Book direct us to be holy, to understand the requirements of God's Law, to confess our sin and seek God for pardon. We affirm our common Faith in the Nicene or Apostle's Creed, and we are instructed in the

proclamation of the Gospel during the sermon. As the church has historically maintained worship which combines WORD and SACRAMENT, our Book of Common Prayer (being more than 70% direct quotations from Scripture) also includes service for the administration of Holy Communion within the context of God's Word. It should also be pointed out that the Book of Common Prayer does not prohibit or restrict the freedom of each person to worship God in prayer.
